Policy Statement | Kaupapa Here

- 1. Relocation assistance will be offered to continuing Academic (Lecturer to Professor) and Senior Leadership appointees (and by agreement to other appointees where appropriate) and their spouse/partner and dependent children. The basis of funding for any relocation must be agreed to in writing prior to actual relocation.
- 2. This policy recognises the immediate family relationship of legally married spouses, couples in a de facto relationship and dependent children of either spouse/partner
