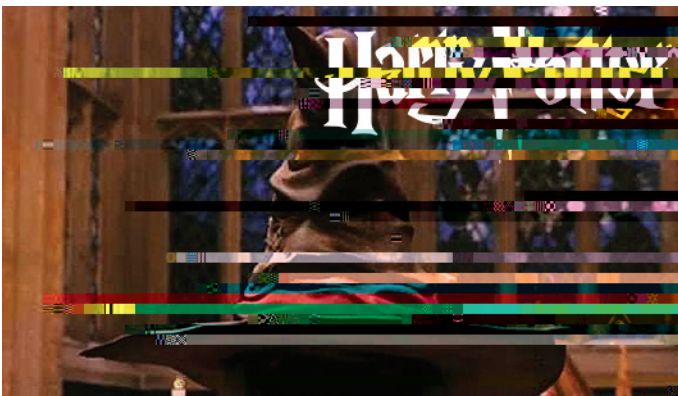

Subject(s) to study: Economics and/or Finance



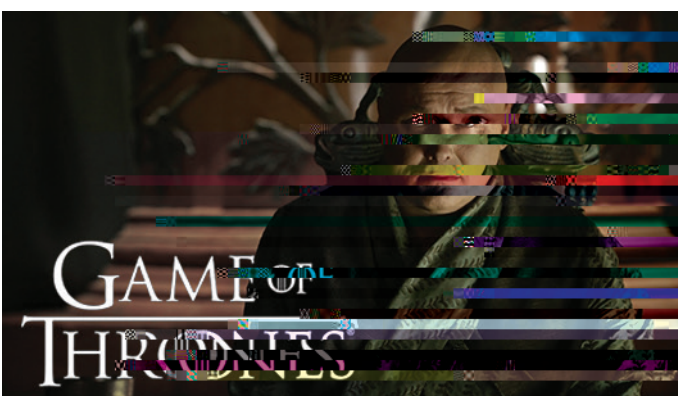
A recruitment specialist is responsible for managing the recruitment and selection (or sorting!) of new talent into the organisation.

A system security specialist protects an organisation's network and databases. This can involve managing spyware and virus protection software to protect against hostile entities.

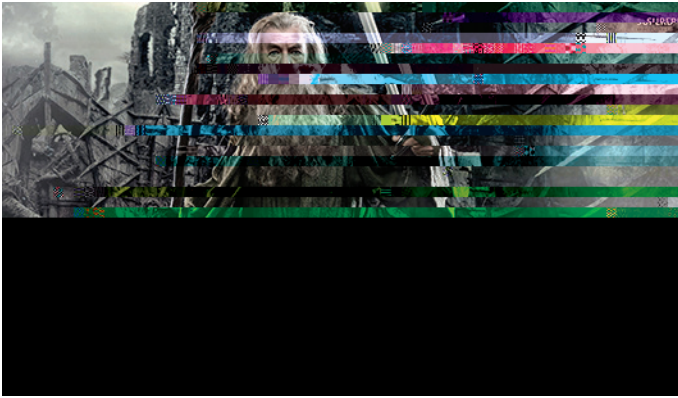
Subject(s) to study: Information Systems

Subject(s) to study: International Business



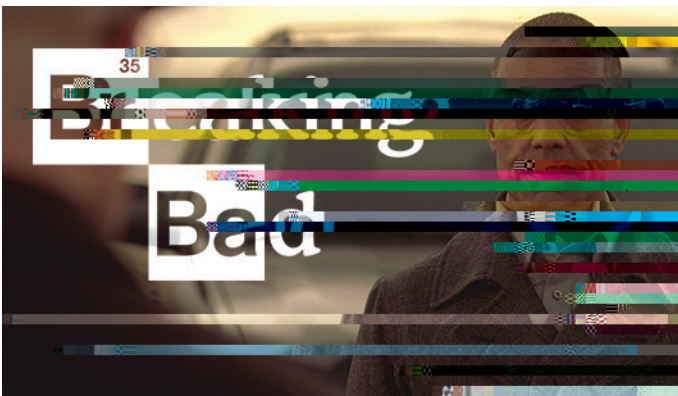

Creative directors oversee the formulation and development of advertising campaigns. This role involves using their creative expertise to turn the clients vision into a tangible and deliverable product.

An operations and production manager is in charge of supervising and assessing the production process, as well as managing organisational logistics and distribution of 'the product'.
